Letter from J. B. Henry to Louisa Anderson giving his itinerary to Annapolis; wants to hear more from the new baby; her picture pleases every and will sent one to; there were parties for those attached to the Academy and a separate one for the town ladies; Miss Mason married Lieut. Lessing; Johnny Randall and his brother-in-law will accompany him to Currituck. Badly water damaged. Envelope with postmark and stamp detached, badly water damaged, addressed to Mrs. J. Buchanan Henry, care Dr. W. C. Anderson, Stapleton, Staten Island, New York. Annapolis, Maryland, Thursday [29 October 1874]. Date from postmark.
