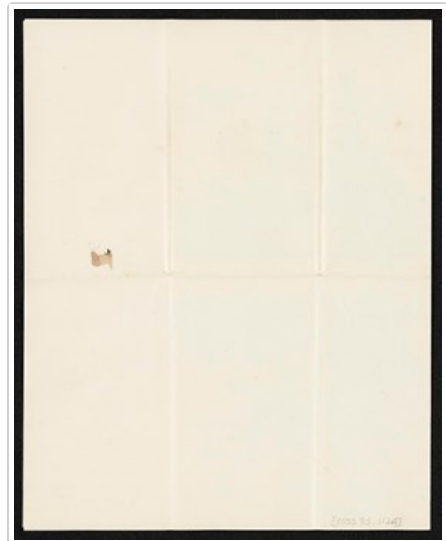
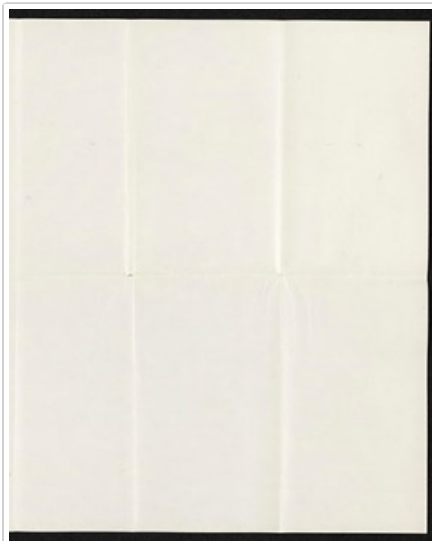
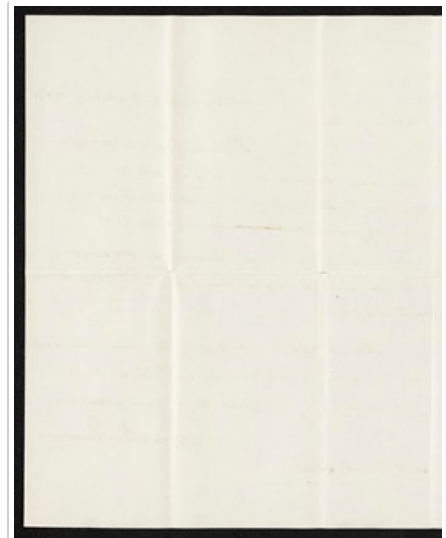
Washington 2 August 1847
