My dear Sir,

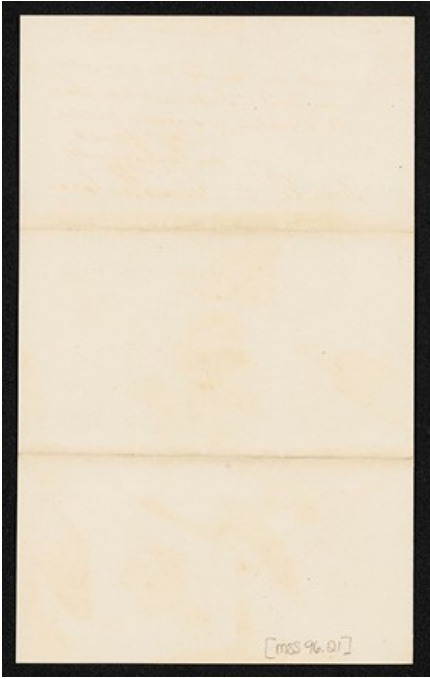
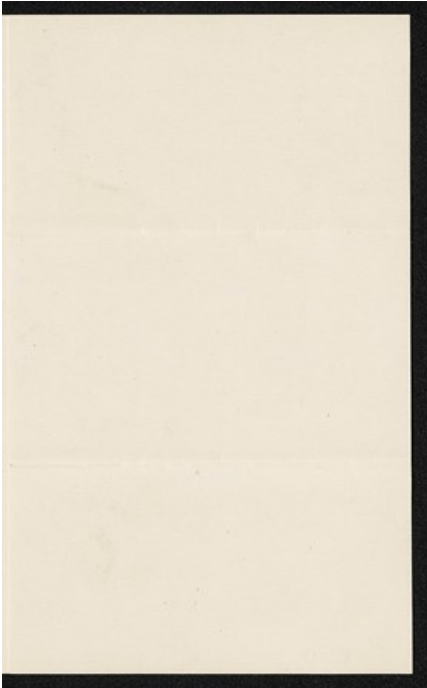
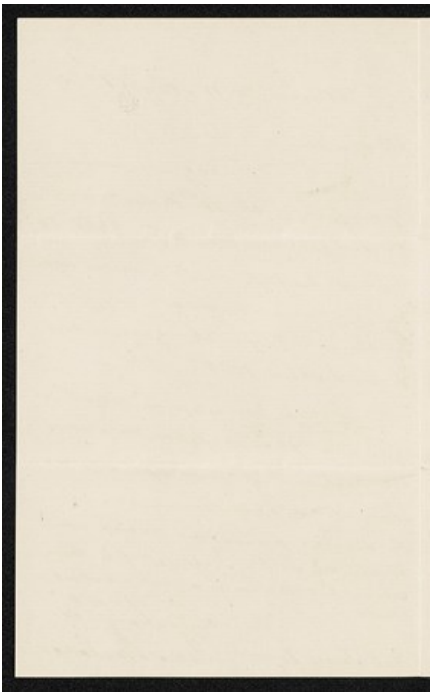
I have received your favor of the 10th Instant, with the Certificate of Deposit for \$448.⁰⁰50.

I saw two releases which you will please to deliver to Messrs. M. H. H. I wish you would some day at your leisure ascertain the amount due on his mortgage which exceeds my debt. I do not like these releases; but H. H. is a good & valuable friend.
