He therefore requires the Prothonotary of the said Court, to enter & record the above as a lien, as well against the building or tenement situate & described as aforesaid, as against Gottlieb Young owner or reputed owner thereof, agreeably to the provisions of the several acts of Assembly in such case made & provided.
