YOU are hereby commanded, that the Body of *Charles Allen* ^{*alias Abraham Miller*} under your custody detained, as it is said, together with the day and cause of *his* being taken and detained, by whatsoever name the said *Charles Allen* shall be charged in the same, you have, under safe and secure conduct, before ~~the honorable~~ *Walter Franklin Esquire, President of the Court of Common Pleas for the County of Lancaster;* on *Saturday the 20th day of August instant* in the borough of Lancaster, at *10* o'clock, in the *fore* noon; to do and receive all those things which the said Judge shall then and there consider of in this particular.

WITNESS the honorable *Walter Franklin*, Esquire, President of the Court of Common Pleas of said County, at Lancaster, the *sixteenth* day of *August* in the year of our LORD, one thousand eight hundred and *fourteen*
