The Condition of this Obligation is such that if the above bound Magdalene Light Administratrix of all & singular the Goods & Chattels rights & credits of Joseph Light late of Lancaster Deed (with the testamt of the sd Deed) do make or cause to be made a true & perfect Inventory of all & singular the Goods & Chattels rights & credits of the sd Deed which have or shall come to the hands possession or knowledge of the sd Magdalene Light or into the hands possession or knowledge of any other person or persons for her & the same so made do Exhibit or cause to be exhibited into the Register Generals Office at Lancaster at or before the thirtieth day of June next & the same Goods & Chattels which were of the sd Deed at the time of his Death or which at any time hereafter shall come to the hands or possession of the sd Magdalene Light or into the hands or possession of any other person or persons for he do well & truly Administer according to Law & further do make or cause to be made a true & just account of the sd Administration at or before the last & before the thirtieth day of June anno Dom: 1734 & all the rest & residue of the sd Goods & Chattels rights & credits which shall be found remaining upon the said Administratrix's account the same being first Examined & allowed of by the Orphans Court of the County of Lancaster shall Deliver & pay to such persons & in such a Manner as by the last will & testamt of the sd Deed is ordered & decreed when this Obligation to be void or else to be & remain in full force & virtue
