End Benjamin Clark — all — of the County of Lancaster & Province  
of Pennsylvania aforesaid are held & firmly bound unto William Plumsted Esq;  
Registers Gent: on the sum of two hundred & ten Pounds to full Money of Pens:  
to be paid unto the said William Plumsted Esq: or to his certain Attorney  
Executors Administrators or Assigns To the which paymt wchly truly to be  
made we bind our selves jointly & severally our Hrs Executors & Admrs  
each & every of them firmly by these presents sealed with our Seals & dated  
the sixth day of March — in the year of our Lord 1746/7

The Condition of this Obligation is such that if the abovebounden Marg:  
Williams Administratrix of all & singular the Goods & Chattels &  
Credits of John Williams Decedent do make or cause to be made at her effect  
Inventory of all & singular the Goods Chattels & Credits of the said Deed which at the  
time of his Death or which at any time after shall come to the hands possession  
or know ledge of the said Marg: Williams unto the hands or possession of any other  
Person or Person for him; & the same so made do exhibit the same into the Regt  
Office at Lancaster before the 15th day of April next & further do make  
or cause to be passed at true & just Account Calculacion or Reckning of thy  
Administration on or before the 15th day of March next & all heretofore  
Residues of the said Goods Chattels & Credits which shall be found  
Remaining upon the said Accts the same being first Examined & allow'd  
by the Orphans Court of the said County shall then & pay to such person  
or persons respectively as the said Orphans Court by their Decree or  
Sentences shall Limit & appoint & if it shall hereafter appear that any  
last will & Testament was made by the said Decedent & the Testator or he  
therin named do exhibit the same into the Registers Office making  
Request to have it allowed & approved accordingly of the said Marg:  
Williams being therunto required do render & deliver up such letters  
of Administration Approbation of such Testament being first had &  
made in the Regt Office then the above Obligation to be void & of no  
effect or else to remain in full force & Virtue <sup>Mark of</sup> Margaret & William
