K NOW all Men, by these Presents, that We
Sarah Hopkins Widow of John Hopkins late of
Salsbury Township Deceased and John Clemson
and James Clemson of the same Township

all of the County of *Lancaster*, and Province of *Pennsylvania* are held & firmly bound unto *William Plumsted* Esq; Register General for the Probate of Wills, and granting Letters of Administration in the Province of *Pennsylvania*, in the Sum of *Three thousand Pounds*, Lawful Money of the said Province, to be paid unto the said *William Plumsted* - or to his certain Attorney, Executors, Administrators, or Assigns: To the which Payment well and truly to be made, We do bind ourselves, jointly and severally, our Heirs, Executors and Administrators, each and every of them, firmly by these Presents. Sealed with our Seals, and dated this *Nineteenth* Day of *September* in the Year of our Lord, *One Thousand Seven Hundred and Sixty Four*

THE CONDITION of the above Obligation
is such, That if the above-bounden *Sarah Hopkins*

Administratrix of all and singular the Goods and Chattels, Rights and Credits, which were of *John Hopkins* Deceased, Do make, or cause to be made, a true and perfect Inventory of all and singular the Goods and Chattels, Rights and Credits, which were of the said Decedent at the Time of *his* Death; or which at any other Time has, or shall, come to the Hands, Possession, or Knowledge of the said *Sarah Hopkins*

or unto the Hands or Possession of any other Person or Persons for *her use* and the same so made, do exhibit into the Register's Office at *Lancaster*, at or before the *Nineteenth* Day of *December* next ensuing, and the same Goods, Chattels and Credits, Do well and truly administer, according to Law, and further Do make, or cause to be made, a true and just Account, Calculation or Reckoning of the said Administration, on or before the *Nineteenth* Day of *September* next, which will be in the Year of our Lord, *One Thousand Seven Hundred & Sixty Five* - and all the Rest and Residue of the said Goods, Chattels and Credits, which shall be found remaining upon the said Administrator's Account [the same being first examined, and approved of, by the Orphan's Court of the County aforesaid] Do deliver and pay to such Person or Persons respectively, as the said Orphan's Court, by their Decree or Sentence, pursuant to the true Intent and Meaning of an Act, intituled, "an Act for the better settling Intestates Estates," shall limit and appoint. And if it shall hereafter appear, that any last Will and Testament was made by the Decedent, and the Executor or Executors therein named, do exhibit the same into the Register's Office at *Lancaster*, making Request to have it allowed and approved accordingly, if the said *Sarah Hopkins the Administratrix*

above bounden, being thereunto required, Do render and deliver up the said Letters of Administration [Approbation of such Testament being first had & made in the Register's Office] then the above Obligation to be void, and of none Effect, else to remain in full Force and Virtue.
