*Margaret Stout Isaac Whitelock and*  
*Michael Hubbley Esquire*

all of the County of Lancaster and Province of Pennsylvania, are held and  
firmly bound unto *Benjamin Chew* Esq;  
Register General for the Probate of Wills and granting Letters of Ad-  
ministration in the Province of Pennsylvania, in the Sum of *Two*  
*Hundred* Pounds, Lawful Money of the said Province, to be  
paid unto the said *Benjamin Chew* or to his certain Attor-  
ney, Executors, Administrators or Assigns. To the which Payment well  
and truly to be made, We do bind ourselves jointly and severally, our  
Heirs, Executors and Administrators, each and every of them firmly by  
these Presents. Sealed with our Seals and dated the *Twelfth*  
Day of *September* in the Year of our Lord one thousand  
seven hundred and *sixty seven*

**T**HE Condition of the above Obligation is  
such, that if the above bounden *Margaret Stout*

Administratrix of all and singular the Goods and Chattels, Rights and  
Credits, which were of *Duncan Thompson* Deceased, Doth  
make, or cause to be made, a true and perfect Inventory of all and singu-  
lar the Goods and Chattels, Rights and Credits, which were of the said De-  
cedent at the Time of *his* Death; or which at any other Time has, or  
shall, come to the Hands, Possession or Knowledge of the said *Margaret*  
*Stout* or unto the Hands or Possession  
of any other Person or Persons for *her* and the same to be made,  
Doth exhibit in the Register's Office at Lancaster at or before the  
*Twelfth* Day of *October* next ensuing, and the said Goods,  
Chattels and Credits Doth well and truly administer, according to Law,  
and further Doth make, or cause to be made, a true and just Account,  
Calculation or Reckoning of the said Administration on or before the  
*Twelfth* Day of *September* next, which will be in the Year  
of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and *sixty eight*  
and all the Rest and Residue of the said Goods, Chattels and Credits, which  
shall be found remaining upon the said Administrator's Account (the same  
being first examined and approved of by the Orphan's Court of the County  
aforesaid) Doth deliver and pay to such Person or Persons respectively,  
as the said Orphan's Court, by their Decree or Sentence, pursuant to the  
true Meaning and Intent of an Act, intituled: "an Act for the better sett-  
ling Intestate's Estates," shall limit and appoint. And if it shall hereafter appear,  
that any last Will and Testament was made by the Decedent, and the Execu-  
tor or Executors therein named, Doth exhibit the same into the Register's  
Office at Lancaster, making Request, to have it allowed and approved accord-  
ingly, if the said *Margaret Stout*

above bounden being thereunto required, Doth render and deliver up the  
said Letters of Administration, (Approbation of such Testament being first had  
and made in the Register's Office) then the above Obligation to be void and  
of none Effect, else to remain in full Force and Virtue,
