# Know all Men by these Presents,

That *We Samuel B Moore Isaac Moore James Porter and Edward Porter* all of *Drumore Township Lancaster County*

are held and firmly bound unto the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in the sum of *Fifteen hundred* — pounds, to be paid to the said Commonwealth, for the use of the parties interested in the estate of *James Moore* — late of *Drumore Township* deceased, to which payment, well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves jointly and severally, for and in the whole, our heirs, executors, and administrators, firmly by these presents. Sealed with our seals, and dated the *Twenty fourth* — day of *June* — in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and *nine*

## The Condition of this Obligation is such,

That if the above-bounden *Samuel B Moore and Isaac Moore*

Administrators of all and singular the goods, chattels and credits of the said *James Moore* — deceased, do make or cause to be made, a true and perfect inventory of all and singular the goods, chattels and credits of the said deceased, which have or shall come to the hands, possession or knowledge of *Them* the said *Samuel B Moore and Isaac Moore*

or unto the hands and possession of any person or persons for *Them* and the same so made, do exhibit, or cause to be exhibited, into the Register's office, in the county of Lancaster, on or before the *24<sup>th</sup>* — day of *July* — next ensuing; and the same goods, chattels and credits, and all other goods, chattels and credits, of the said deceased, at the time of *his* death, which at any time after shall come to the hands and possession of the said *Samuel B Moore & Isaac Moore*

or unto the hands and possession of any other person or persons, for *Them* do well and truly administer according to law. And further do make, or cause to be made, a true and just account of *their* — said administration, on or before the *twenty fourth* day of *June* — in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and *Ten*. And all the rest and residue of said goods, chattels and credits, which shall be found remaining on the said administrat account, (the same being first examined and allowed by the Orphan's court of the county of Lancaster,) shall deliver and pay unto such person or persons respectively, as the said Orphan's court by their decree or sentence, pursuant to the true intent and meaning of the several laws now in force in this Commonwealth, shall limit and appoint, and if it shall appear hereafter, that any last will and testament was made by the said deceased, and the executor or executors therein named, do exhibit the same into the Register's office making request to have it allowed and approved accordingly; and if then the above-bounden

being thereunto required, do render and deliver the said letters of administration, approbation of such testament being first had and made in the said Register's office, then this obligation to be void and of none effect, or else to remain in full force and virtue.
