person or persons for them & the same so made do Exhibit or cause to be  
Exhibited into the Register General's Office at Lancaster at or Before  
the second - - day of December next ensuing & the same goods Chattels  
& Credits of the s<sup>d</sup> Deed at the time of his death or which at any time  
after shall come to the hands or possession of the s<sup>d</sup> Arthur & James or unto
