

Bedford Springs 13 August 1863

My dear Harriet,

We propose to leave this place on Saturday morning at 6 O'Clock & expect, Deo volente[God willing], to reach Lancaster at 6 in the afternoon. We shall take up Mrs. Nevin at Huntingdon. You will of course send the carriage on Saturday. Should I be assured that Dr. Blake will arrive here on Saturday, I may not leave till Monday; & in that event you will send the carriage on Monday. The House is now entirely full, there being between three and four hundred people in it. I have enjoyed myself more than I expected. With my love to Annie Elisabeth Speer, I remain yours affectionately.
