Lancaster April 4, 1848

I have received from the following persons and deposited to your credit in the Lancaster Bank, for enclosed certificate \$1180. (?) from Judge Lewis for one years interest up to 1st Instant upon his Bond for \$2000 - \$120. from Dr. N. W. Sample, in full Principal & Int of his Bond _____ 1060.
(I gave the Dr. his bond) [] \$1180.

The executors of B. Flynn wish you to take in payment of his Bond the \$4,000 City loan you hold as collateral security; upon inquiry I find that the City 6 percent stock has been selling at par and I presume is now worth that__ Please inform me what I shall say to them?__
