My Dear Sir,

When I mentioned yesterday mentioned Wednesday of next week, as a day on wh [sic] I could conveniently meet you in Phila, I did not think of the fact that I had to go to town on the next day (Thursday) to attend a meeting of the Managers of the Epis.
