My Dear Sir,

I am very much obliged to you for taking the trouble to write out so full a statement of the Auditor's figures. And I see now exactly how to account for the discrepancy between his calculations & mine. He as gone on the supposition, that, according to the agreement, it was necessary only to supplement the Biographical Fund already in our hand, (\$6464.02) so as to bring it up to \$8000, & no more. Hence, while he had made any contribution to the \$750, (correct also,) he has made the quotas of Mrs [sic] Dunham & the Weaver's, to be only sufficient to bring up these two amounts to \$1535.98. Now, the distinct arrangement in the agreement was that all of us who had signed it shd [sic] let our full shares of \$3000 remain in the hands of the Executors, for the increase of the Biographical Fund. Hence, if I am right, Mrs Dunham's quota, ought to have been instead of \$106.27, Three Hundred Dollars (\$300). And the quota of each of the Weaver's & of Jessie Magaw, \$75 instead of \$26.57. This would have made the whole amount to be retained for the Biographical Fund \$1875, instead of \$1535.98. And this amount (\$1875) would have been no-but little if any more than would be necessary at the present prices of the securities in wh [sic] the Fund is invested, to make the Fund amount to \$8000.

I am very sorry that there has been any misunderstanding about this matter. Whether the errors, as I think it, can be corrected without a rewriting of the report, I know not. But if it can, I think is should be done. If on the other hand, the correction of it wd [sic]necessarily in vole a <u>new</u> report, I suppose it better not to attempt it be done, as it would occasion not only trouble but delay.
