

Wheatland 29 April 1865

Dear Sir,

On last evening I received yours of the 22nd instant postmarked at Clarion April 26. On yesterday morning I received yours of the 24th concerning the Mable Judgment, and, also, yours of the 21st, enclosing a draft from the First National Bank of Clarion on the First National Bank of Philadelphia for \$853.85, payable to your order & endorsed by you to me. I observe that you have deducted your commissions on, "Clem osteries (new contract)" at the rate of 7 ½ per cent, instead of 5 per cent as formerly. I was not aware that any new contract had been made. This must have been with Mr. Reynolds; & if so, it is all right. I have never examined carefully the long transactions in regard to the Lucuida property; but for this purpose shall await your general statement. Doubtless all will prove to be correct; but still I desire to be satisfied.
