Hon Jas Buchanan

Dear Sir

Enclosed pleas find a statement of your judgment on Lewis Mahle. You will see by the statement that it is paid off. The money was remitted along with other moneys. We had [Sci for ?] issued to pressure the [sic] him before it was all paid. I wrote you Saturday night in on the receipt of yours after 21<sup>st</sup> inst. To return the check and I will send a draft. Since sending the check I sent you a draft on the first National Bank of Philla. I presume it will be cashed. I have been annoyed that you have been put to so much trouble in the matter.
