

March 18, 1891 [date from folded bill]

Dear Mr. Henry,

I enclose your Schell bill and vouchers – except for the charges of Feb. 5, which are however correct, but have lost the voucher the bill is all right with cts. each – I have here sent over on approval & at once returned. They were not even bought into the house – for you I will handle them -- & when I looked at them I saw they were not what I wanted -- & he took them away with him – keep [text missing] voucher -- & I myself will speak to Schell. I also enclose Dr. J. R.'s receipt with thanks. I received a very nice and manly letter from [J Seth?] & very well written & I feel proud of him -- & glad to see he is taking up his life so cheerfully & bravely. My boys are both well – Jon did not tell me if you would be ale to give the quarters [sic] cheque for L. J. what will be due for R by April 15<sup>th</sup>. I can [track?] if you cannot [pay?] it until May 16 ; but then I much make other provisions for any tax due April 15.

I saw Mrs. Richardson yesterday. I suppose you will soon return.
