Dear Sir,

You are hereby notified of the publication of Academic Honors in Princeton University, 1748-1902, being a list of the Latin and English Salutatorians, Valedictorians, Honorees, Junior Orators, Lynde Debaters, Prize-winners, and First Group Men, since the founding of the college, in both the Academic and scientific departments in which your name appears.

This volume is unique, being the first complete list of honorees and prize winners undertaken by any university. It consists of about 250 pages, octavo, printed from new type, on heavy deckle-edge Old Stratford linen paper, bound in buckram, with the seal of the University in gold on cover. It has been compiled and edited, with an introductory history of the honors, prizes, and fellowships, with notes and an index, by John Rogers Williams.

The edition is strictly limited to 500 copies, which are now in the hands of the binder and will be ready for distribution about November 1, 1902. The price is \$2.50, net, postpaid.
