Dr Sir

Your favor of the 11th is re^d and I allow I was remiss in not explaining in regard to search sent you. Both Eldael W. Goodman & Jos. Fowler are my brothers in law [sic] and living. Mr. Goodman at time of purchase lived in Bolton but now resides on a farm 1 1/2 miles north of our village, having purchased the same about one year ago. Mr. Fowler lives in our Village and is my partner in the lime business. At time of purchase we thought it might be more convenient to have title in some one instead of us three & so concluded to have it conveyed to Mr. Goodman which was done & we have never seen fit – or thought it necessary to change it, as he is not only responsible but is a thoroughly honest man.

There will be the County & State tax due next mo with we will pay. I dont [sic] know of any other tax agst [sic] the property. Mr. Goodman pays the taxes which are small, but I am unable to say about the average. The assessment has been kept low because [?] not improved. I dont [sic] know as to no. of acres but think it called 136. Hoping this will satisfactory [sic] I am
