Sirs

You are hereby required to produce on the trial of that cause a certain deed of partition bearing date on the 29<sup>th</sup> of September 1815 between James Boyd, John Boyd, Samuel Boyd & Joseph Boyd, by which they divided amongst them the real estate which formerly belonged to their father, William Boyd the intestate, as well as that which descended to them on the part of their mother; & also a bond, with warrant of attorney, given by James Boyd to Samuel Boyd in the penalty of \$6000 dated 1<sup>st</sup> April 1823 & on which Judgement [sic] and been entered in the Common Pleas of Lancaster County to April Term 1823 No. 178, & any & all papers in the possession of yourself or your clients relating to the matters in controversy in this suit.
