Washington, 12 October 1847

Dear James,

I have called on Doctor Gunnell which morning who says he will attend you at any time to day or tomorrow that you may call. He lives very near the State Department and Mr. Bartle or myself will accompany you to his house. I shall not again employ Mr. Humphreys. Doctor Gunnell is my own Dentist.

Could you not come out to the Doctor on one of the afternoons in the week when you are not engaged in your studies?
