Madam,

The great-grandmother ~~of your~~ of your child, Dorcas Collins, deceased, held a bond against Robert Cabeen and John Bair, the principal of which after her death became due and [rested?] in her children or their legal representatives by direction of resident heirs. I have collected the bond, to the proceeds of which your deceased husband & father if living would be entitled to the net 1/9th but as he is deceased, your child as one of the seven representatives of James Collins, dec, is entitled to the 1/7th of the 1/9th or \$9.

If your child is of age, let it sign the subjoined receipt, if not? You sign as the mother giving child's name, or if the child has a guardian let him sign, and return the same, when I will remit the amount due.
