Ephraim Carpenter, of East Township, said County, Millwright files this his claim, for the payment of eighty nine dollars and fifty one cents, against all that certain two story Grist Mill 64½ feet by 31 feet two inches in size, with Saw Mill attached, situated in Ephrata Township said County, with the lot of ground and Curtilage appurtenant to said building; the said sum of eighty nine dollars & fifty one cents, being a balance due & unpaid, of a contract of seven hundred dollars, being for mill wright work done and Materials, Burs &c furnished in putting up the works of said Mill, within six months last past, the last work having been done on the fifth day of January, last past, of which Mill the said Jacob S. Grop was the owner & reputed owner, and at his instance & request the said Mill Works being put up, he being the contractor, and the said Ephraim Carpenter, claims to have a Lien on said Mill and piece of ground and Curtilage appurtenant thereto from the commencement thereof, for the sum aforesaid, of \$89.51, according to the act of assembly in such case made and provided.
