Salisbury Store waste books, 1794-1797:

Folder 1 Contains 162 pages dated 28 May - 20 Nov. 1794. (*Disbound 1987, covers badly damaged.*)

Folder 2 Contains 192 pages dated 21 Nov. 1794 - 10 July 1795. (*Disbound 1987, covers badly damaged.*)

Folder 3 Contains 194 pages dated 10 July 1795 - 20 Oct. 1797.

Folder 4 Salisbury Store account book, 1790-1794. Recorder unknown. Book contains 187 pages with an index in the front. The first pages are almost completely deteriorated. (*Disbound 1987, covers badly damaged.*)

Folder 5 Geography school workbook written by Jasper Slaymaker, 1805.

Henry Slaymaker recorded the Justice of the Peace dockets chronologically in 2 books, listing the plaintiff and defendant. Records include signatures. (Earlier book was disbound in 1987. Second book is in good condition.)

Folder 8 School exercise book dated 9 Dec. 1829. Miss Isabella Slaymaker's book of 28 pages from the Bethania Seminary, Lancaster County. It is a book of instructions and problems by Mr. P. Chambers on arithmetic problems, including the conversion of cloth measurements to/from French, Flemish, and English. Solutions to the questions by Miss Slaymaker. At the back of the workbook are names of pupils in the Seminary, and a list of reading, geography, spelling, and arithmetic lessons.

Folder 9 Summons, receipts, letters, promissory notes, etc. 19 items. 1825-1829.

Folder 10 Summons, receipts, letters, promissory notes, etc. 17 items. 1831-1835.
