TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

Whereas, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved March 3, 1855, entitled "An Act in addition to certain Acts granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the Military Service of the United States," there has been deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE, Warrant No 44855 for 80 acres, in favor of Philip Noel, Senior, Private, Captain Roops Company Ohio Militia War 1812. With evidence that the same has been duly located upon the East half the South West quarter of Section thirty two in Township eighty six North of Range seventeen West in the District of Lands formerly subject to sale at Dubuque, now For Des Moines, Iowa, containing eighty acres. According to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL the said warrant having been assigned by the said Philip Noel Senior to Oliver Perry S. Fee, in whose favor said tract has been located.

Now know ye, that there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said Oliver Perry S. Fee, as assignee as aforesaid and to his heirs the tract of Land above described: to have and to hold the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Oliver Perry S. Fee as assigned as aforesaid and to his heirs and assigns forever

In Testimony Whereof, I James Buchanan PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the SEAL OF THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE to be hereunto affixed.

GIVEN under my hand, at the CITY OF Washington, the sixteenth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty and the INDEPENDENCE OF THE UNITED STATES the eighty fifth.
