

Know all Men by these Presents, that we Jacob F. Kautz and Barbara Kautz, his wife of the City of Lancaster, in the County of Lancaster, and the State of Pennsylvania are held and firmly bound unto James Buchanan of Lancaster Township, County and State aforesaid in the sum of Three Thousand dollars lawful money of the United States to be paid to the said James Buchanan or to his certain Attorney, Executors, Administrators or Assigns. To which payment, well and truly to be made and done, we do bind ourselves and each of us by him and herself, for and in the while our Heirs, Executors and Administrators, and every of them, firmly by these Presents.

Sealed with our Seals, dated the Seventh day of April in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and sixty four. The Condition of the above Obligation is such, That if the above bounden Jacob F. Kautz and Barbara Kautz his wife or either of them, their or either of their Heirs, executors, Administrators or any of them, shall and do well and truly pay, or cause to be paid unto the above named James Buchanan or to his certain Attorney, Executors, Administrators or Assigns, the just and full sum of Fifteen hundred dollars (\$1500) lawful money aforesaid with legal interest for the same, on the first day of April, Anno Domini, One thousand eight hundred and Sixty-eight (1868) (Interest payable annually on the first of April) without fraud or further delay, then the above Obligation to be void and of none effect; otherwise to be and remain in full force and virtue.
