This letter which I have just received from Fanny Coleman is certainly very strong evidence – I should think, conclusive evidence when coupled with what my Mother often told me. As my Mother expressed it, her Aunt died of a broken heart. Probably in those days hearts were not such perilous organs as they seem to be now and one who in early life died of heart disease might also have been spoken of as dying of a broken heart.

Fanny Coleman, as you doubtless know, is a daughter of Dawson Coleman who was my mother's first cousin.
