THAT “THE WOODWARD HILL CEMETERY,” for and in consideration of the sum of Fifty Dollars to them in hand paid by Charles Smith at and before the ensealing and delivery hereof, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, by these presents do grant, bargain, sell release, convey and confirm unto the said Smith his heirs and assigns, for no other purpose than for the burial of deceased white persons, and for all objects and purposes incident thereto, one LOT OF GROUND in the “WOODWARD HILL CEMETERY,” in the CITY OF LANCASTER, Numbered 7 of Section or Division marked Plat one in the general plan of the “WOODWARD HILL CEMETERY.” Together with the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging. To have and to hold the same to the said Charles Smith his Heirs and Assigns to and for his and their own sole and exclusive use, benefit, advantage and behoof forever. Under and subject to all rules and regulations from time to time fixed, prescribed and determined by the party of the first part hereto and their successors, for the government of said Cemetery.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the said party of the first part have hereunto set their Corporate Seal, this Second day of June in the year of our Lord, Eighteen Hundred and Eighty Three
