Insert 3 Invitation to the Third Annual Picnic by the Octoraro "Merry Six" at J. T. Barnard's Grove, near Bell Bank. Music by Keffer's Orchestra. Lists floor managers and committee on invitation. 29 July 1876.

Invitation to a Social Evening Pic-nic at Evan's Picnic Grounds, near Beartown. Lists managers and floor managers. 8 September 1877. (2 copies)



Insert 4 Invitation to the First Grand Hop of the Season to be held at Philip Rheas', one mile east of Unicorn. Music by Brown's Orchestra. Lists managers. 12 August 1880. **Insert 5** Invitation to the Grand Social Picnic at William Whitman's Grove, Wrightsdale. Lists managers, floor managers, treasurer, and committee on invitation. 29 July 1882.

Folder 4 Trade card for Edward J. Zahm, jeweler. Zahm's Corner (Centre Square and North Queen Street), Lancaster. Advertising holiday gifts. Printed on postcard. December 17.
