Dear Anna

I must write you a letter again I was not shur the last time if you would gettit or not I am well at present and sink you are thesame we lay about five miles from Fredericksburg wehre we lay in Camp we expecd to march away hier very sune till the britges are finisht an our march of to Fred,g. we had five from our man captured and the was turnt back to Washington again I think we will bee at home in about four months and I think I will see you well last night we ceme back from piket to day we was out an a [refiew] wehr our Generals sat that we lookt well and kleen I resive them glase you sent to me and I am very much aplease to you I sent to liesy a copler papers if you like to have more let my nohn in your next letter we gat [flenthy] to eat the nigger the rune around in camp every day with hohtkeeks. I think your Corn must be out by this time in about a months time we will be in Richmonth. I must close my letter an say
