## Book 1 Journal of the Conestoga Steam Mill

A complete financial record of the company from September 17, 1845 to March 29, 1857. It includes the names of and dividends paid to stockholders; officers of the company; capital gains and losses; general account balances; monthly operatives costs including labor, materials, equipment, etc; mortgages, loans and interests paid to such banks as Farmer's Bank and Lancaster County Bank; and the purchase and sale of No.1, and subsequently, No. 3 Mill.

## Book 2 Ledger of the Conestoga Steam Mill

From the records of the journal, the ledger contains more detailed information and accounts records of each stockholders starting from August 1845. It also contains the comprehensive records of financial matter related to the company including profit and loss, bills receivable and payable, mortgages and loans, balances, account expenses, and records of expenses, purchase, and/or sale pertaining manufactures, clothes, commissions, and freights.

Note: The front end paper of the Ledger is nearly torn off. There's a large split between the front cover and spine, still held together by the dust jacket. Binding coming loose.
