Two newspaper articles pasted back-to-back on cardboard. First article details a handkerchief party thrown for Miss Jennie Gorman, teacher at the North Star School, on St. Patrick's Day. 21 March 1908. Second article titled, "A Handkerchief Surprise" discusses the same party as described above. No date.

Monthly report card for George N. LeFevre, Jr. from the North Star School, Strasburg Township Schools. Teacher, Ms. Jennie Gorman. Signed by father, George N. LeFevre. Five reports total: three not dated, one dated 25 March 1903, one dated 22 March 1905.

Newspaper article, photocopy, titled "The Battle". Describes B. F. Gorman's purchase of a drop-forged steel coffee grinder powered by a Robbins and Myers motor for his grocery store. Store was located at the southeast corner of Lemon and Mulberry Streets, Lancaster. Article describes how the independent grocer provides service while the chain grocer provides lower prices. Article serves as an ad and testimonial for the store and the coffee grinder. At the end of the article is an ad for Russell Sales Company, Grant and Christian Streets, Lancaster. No date.
