




My dear Mr Henry: —

San Antonio, Texas.

Oct 27.

I am so glad to get your 23^d & to know you are home safe & sound. As to "dying", (as you kindly suggest our both doing) Bro! — We want to live now. The time for the "Great Change", in the year 1941, which is predicted in XII Chap. Daniel, is now so near, that surely you will wait to see it, when you are so interested in all things new? — I must try to, anyhow, Don't discourage me that way!

Chaos! Here, a month ago, a white man who outraged

About a 100 miles from here this last month a white
man outraged a girl 8 years old & was tried for it
& got 5 years in jail! Last month a negro
assaulted a white woman, was arrested & confessed, and
the judge of the district told the Sheriff to take him
out and hang him, & the Sheriff did so forthwith,
without trial of any sort, or lawyer!! Another negro at
Dallas was tried for another crime this month &
found guilty & the judge there sentenced him to be

returned to jail & later executed, whereupon in two minutes the Sheriff calmly delivered the culprit to a mob who at once hung him to a lamp post in front of the Court House. Law and Real Estate are all mixed. No one can tell where he will come out. Collection of debts & loans is impossible. Buyers from the north are misled, & soon ruined in West Texas, & East Texas is exceedingly unhealthy. There are, of course, some good, well watered ranches. They are splendid productive properties & give a glorious life. But — if, by any chance, they come on the market the Texas owners ask ten times their actual value. To me, who have lived in antebellum days amongst the old time South Carolina & Georgia planters, who with all their faults were personally honorable, a Texan is a repulsive dirty beast! — A mere Fakir! That Dr Hammond in Washington & the Congress, Hudd, have dropped out of my horizon since Davidge's death. It is many months since I have heard of them, but I see the U.S. is looking up (too late) the cooling station business. —
