Articles between Thaddeus Stevens & J. F. Caven

Articles of agreement made this 17th day of July 1862 between John F. Caven and Thaddeus Stevens witnesseth the said Stevens agrees to sell and hereby does sell to Caven a certain tract of land in the coal region of Luzerne County in Jefferson Township Penn by the warranted name of Joseph Brew or Run containing five hundred acres more or less valued at one hundred and fifty dollars per acre, for which said Caven agrees to sell and duly transfer to said Stevens seventy ^{five} thousand dollars ^{worth} (per value) of stock transferrable, in the Leavenworth & Western Rail Road ^{Co.} in Kansas, the title to which he guarantees the deed to be made so soon as the said stock shall be duly transferred on the books of the company.
