3. Receipt from Jacob Riem. 10 shillings, signed Henry [] (illegible), November 2, 1751.

4. Receipt from Jacob Rihm. 12 pounds for half ton of [] (illegible), signed David Jenkin, March 29, 1758.

5. Receipt from Jacob Rihm. 10 pounds in part for nine acres in Donegal Twp. joining John Stauffer, Peter Blaser, Leonard Negely, and Henry Eckenrode. Signed James Cunningham, May 21, 1770.

6. Receipt from Jacob Riem. 9 pounds in part of one bond due next May 16th. Signed Samuel Smith, April 20, 1773.
