

We agree that the sum of three thousand Dollars shall be discounted by us at the Office of discount & deposit at Lancaster and the Money so discounted shall be placed in the Hands of Michael Rine who is immediately to proceed to the County of Northumberland or the adjacent Counties thereof and at the most reasonable rates to purchase Wheat Rye & Flour for the same on account of the joint profit or loss of us, that the said Michael Rine immediately on his return to Lancaster shall render an account to Jacob Graeff & John Hubley or either of them in what manner he has disposed of the said Money and at what prices or rates he made purchases thereof, that on the arrival of the Wheat Rye & Flour the said Wheat Rye & Flour shall be disposed of in such manner as we or any two of us shall direct and that the monies arising on the sale of the Wheat Rye & Flour aforesaid after deducting the real costs and Charges shall be applied to the Debt contracted in the Office aforesaid and the profits if any shall be equally divided amongst us Witness our Hands this 19th February 1805. —
