

Memorandum, It is agreed between William Hamilton Esq. & Mr Jacob Krug as follows respecting the Wood & Timber on the Lancaster Estate between the Roads to Harris's Ferry & Wrights Ferry, Viz. That the said Jacob shall & may cut down remove & convert to his own Use the Wood & Timber aforesaid grow on the ungranted parts of the said Estate between the Roads aforesaid & shall have liberty to remove the same until the first Day of May 1791, at which Time the said Lands are to be cleared unless a further Privilege or Time is allowed by the said William: In Consideration whereof the said Jacob agrees to pay to the said William fifty Pounds in Hand and the further Sum of one hundred & sixty Pounds on or before the seventeenth Day of November next, & to cut down & remove the Wood & Timber aforesaid within the Term aforesaid. In Witness whereof the said Parties have hereunto set their Hands the seventeenth Day of October 1789.

It is also agreed between the within Parties that John Bladensburg
shall compute the Quantity of Wood growing on the Pasture now occupied
by Jacob King & Jasper Yeates & that the said Jacob shall cut down
& remove the Wood & Timber thereon within the Term mentioned
within and that the said Jacob shall pay unto the said Willison
therefor within one Month at the Rate of three Shillings & six
pence per every Acre thereof. 14 October 1789.
