

To Joseph Hubley of the County of Lancaster Esquire

Whereas by a certain Deed of Mortgage bearing date the 2^d May 1771 recorded in the Office for recording of Deeds for said County in Book O page 449 of George Tedderhoff of Bethel Township in the said County of Lancaster granted unto me a certain Messuage or Tenement Plantation & Tract of Land situate late in Lancaster now in Dauphin County adjoining the Land of James M. Neas, Peter Gray, George Mase, Jacob Turney, Abram Weidman & Peter Ruthy respectively containing two hundred & twenty four Acres & three quarters Together with the Appurtenances, To hold to me my Heir & Assigns forever, with a Proviso therein contained to be void upon the payment of four hundred & seventy Pounds with Interest as by the said Mortgage may more at large appear, And Whereas I have been fully paid the said principal sum of four hundred & seventy Pounds and all the Interest due thereon, There are therefore to Authorise and empower you the said Joseph Hubley to repair to the said Office for recording of Deed for said County and there for me & in my Name & Deed to acknowledge satisfaction according to Law in the Margin of the record of the said Mortgage before the Recorder of Deeds for said County and for so doing this shall be your sufficient Warrant, Witness my Hand & Seal at Philadelphia this 30th Septemb: 1789
