

In Pursuance of an Act of Assembly of  
the State of Pennsylvania I John Hubley  
Clerk of the Peace for the County of Lancaster  
residing in the Borough of Lancaster do  
hereby enter and return that (to the best of  
my knowledge) Hannah a Mulatto female  
Child the Daughter of Negro Juddy a Female  
Slave, was born on or about the twelfth day  
of June one thousand seven hundred and eighty  
seven: and that her said Mother Juddy was  
duly entered and Registered by me at Lancaster  
on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of October 1780 as a Slave, pursu-  
ant to the Act "for the gradual abolition of  
Slavery." and that the aforesaid Mulatto  
Child Hannah is my property and liable  
to serve untill she arrives to the age of  
twenty eight Years. — Witness my Hand  
this 26<sup>th</sup> day of February 1789. —  
John Hubley
