In Pursuance of an Act of Assembly of the State of
Pennsylvania I ^{Iron Master} Cyrus Jacobs; of the County
of Lancaster Residing in the Township of Warwick
do Herby Enter & Return that to the best of my
Knowledge Since a Negro; ^{Female} Child the Daughter of
Negro Pol a Female Slave, was born in March One
Thousand Seven Hundred and Eighty one: and that her said
mother Pol was duly Entered and Registered ~~by~~ in the
Clerks Office at Lancaster as a Slave. Pursuant to the
Act for the gradual abolition of Slavery, and that
the aforesaid Negro Child Since is my Property and
liable to serve until she arrives to the age of
Twenty Eight years — Witness my Hand this
10th day of March 1789 —
