

In pursuance of an Act of Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania, I John Johnston of the Township of Sadsbury in the County of Lancaster, Husbandman, Do hereby enter and return That (to the best of my Knowledge) Ben a Negro Male Child the Son of Negro Esther a Female Slave, was born in or about the Month of March or April in the Year of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred and Eighty seven, and that Ruth a Negro Female Child the Daughter of the said Negro Esther, was born in the Month of August in the Year of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred and Eighty seven and that the said Esther (the Mother of the said Ben and Ruth) was duly entered and registered by me at Lancaster as a Slave, pursuant to the Act "For the Gradual Abolition of Slavery" and also that the aforesaid two Negro Children are my Property, and liable to serve until they shall severally arrive to the Age of Twenty eight years. Witness my Hand the 25th Day of March A.D. 1789.
