March One Thousand Seven Hundred and Eighty nine and that their
said Mother Mary was duly Entered and Registered at Lancaster as a Slave
pursuant to the Act for the gradual Abolition of Slavery and that the
aforesaid Whiloven is my property and liable to serve until she
arrive to the age of twenty eight Years - Witness my hand this 27th
Day of March 1789
