 State of Pennsylvania do hereby Enter and Return
 that to the best of my knowledge Esther a Negroe
 Famel Child the Daughter of Negroe Rose a Slave
 was ^{Born} about the middle of Janiary one thousand seven
 hundred and Eighty seven and that his Mother
 Rose was Duely Entered and Registered by Robert
 Spear at Lancaster as a Slave pursuant to the
 act for gradual abetation of Slavery and that
 the aforesaid Negroe Child Esther is my property
 and liable to serve untill she arrives to the age
 of Twenty eight years
