In pursuance of an Act of Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania I John Hubley Clerk of the Peace for the County of Lancaster residing in the Borough of Lancaster do hereby enter and return that (to the best of my knowledge) Phillis a Negro female Child the Daughter of Negro Juddy a Female Slave was born on or about the third day of June one thousand seven hundred and ninety: and that her said Mother Juddy was duly Registered by me at Lancaster the 9th day of October 1780 as a Slave agreeable to Law; and that the aforesaid Negro Child Phillis is my property and liable to serve until she arrives to the Age of twenty eight Years Witness my Hand this eighth day of July 1790.
