of Pennsylvania, I William Conkle of Bart
Township in the County of Lancaster Blacksmith
do hereby enter and Return Hannah, a Molattoe
Female Child daughter of Negro Sib, a Female
Slave was born on the third day of January in the
year of our Lord One Thousand Seven hundred and
Sixty two, and that her said Mother Sib was duly
Entered and Registered at Lancaster as a Slave
pursuant to the act, for the gradual abolition of
Slavery, and that the aforesaid Molattoe Child Hannah
is my Property and Liable to serve until it shall
arrive to the age of Twenty Eight years, Witness
my hand the first day of June in the year of
our Lord One Thousand Seven hundred and Sixty two
