and Ninety two, and that her said Mother, Abigail hath been
duly entered and registered at Lancaster as a Slave, pursuant to the
Act "for the gradual abolition of Slavery" and that the aforesaid
Motator Child Triscilla is my Property and liable to serve until
it shall attain the Age of Twenty eight years. Witness my Hand
the Tenth Day of May in the Year of our Lord One thousand
Seven hundred and Ninety three
