

In pursuance of an Act of Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania, I Zachariah Moore of the Township of Donegal in the County of Lancaster, Farmer, do hereby enter and return That Rachel, a Negroe Female Child, the Daughter of Negroe Lucia a Female Slave, was born on the fourth Day of January in the Year of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred and Ninety three, and that her said Mother Lucia was duly entered and registered at Lancaster as a Slave pursuant to the Act "for the gradual Abolition of Slavery" and that the aforesaid Negroe Child Rachel is my Property, and liable to serve until it shall arrive to the Age of Twenty eight years Witness my Hand the Twenty ninth Day of May, in the Year of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred and Ninety three
