Molator Male Child the Son of Negroe Diana a Female Slave
was born on the first Day of December in the Year of our Lord
One thousand Seven hundred and Ninety one, and that his
said Mother Diana was duly entered and registered at Lancaster
as a Slave, pursuant to the Act "for the gradual Abolition of
Slavery" and that the aforesaid Molator Child Isaac is
my Property, and liable to serve until it shall arrive to the
Age of Twenty eight Years. Witness my Hand the Thirtieth
Day of May in the year of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred
and Ninety two
