

Know all Men by these Presents that I W^m Porter
of the Township of Little Britain County of Lancaster & State of
Pennsylvania for and in consideration of the sum of four
hundred & twenty pounds Lawfull Money of the State afore-
said to me in hand paid by Andrew Porter of the Town-
ship County & State aforesaid at or before the sealing and
Delivery of these presents the Receipt whereof I the said W^m
Porter do hereby acknowledge Have granted bargained and
sold and by these presents Doth grant bargain and sell
to the s^r. Andrew Porter his heir Executors Administrators or
Assigns (Viz.) All my Movable Astate that is to say, one Negroe
Man named Abner aged thirty four years one d^o. named
Abbe aged twenty years one d^o. named Senaca aged four-
teen years one Negroe Woman named Fanny, aged twenty
nine years one Negroe Girl named Reach aged eight years
one Negroe Girl named Dark aged five years, one Negroe
Woman named Jean aged twenty one years one Negroe Boy
named Ned aged five years and also one Negroe Girl nam-
ed Peg aged two years also one Negroe Boy named Benn
aged four years and one Negroe Woman named Else aged
twenty years and the said Els child caled Sam. Also one
brown gelding aged eight years, also two Mares & one Colt
and seventeen head of horned cattel, thirty six Sheep,
forty hogs, Together with all my household furniture
and farming Utentials, To him the s^r. Andrew Porter
his heirs Executors administrators or assigns.

To have and to hold all and singular the s^d. Negroes
and Cattle and furniture & farming Utentials above menti-
oned and described to the proper use and behoof of him the
said Andrew Porter his heirs Executors Administrators and
Assigns forever. And the said W^m Porter for myself my
heirs Executors and administrators do all and singular
of the above described Goods for ever warrant and defend to s^d.
Andrew Porter his heirs Executors Administrators or assigns
against all manner of persons having any claim to the
same. In Witness whereof I have hereto set too and affixed
my hand & seal this twenty sixth day of July one thou-
sand seven hundred & Eighty five - William Porter

N.B. One Negroe named Cyrus aged eighteen years
which was neglected to be mentioned in the within Bill
of sale, but noted here before signing and delivering.
Lancaster County ss. Before me Henry Dehuff Esq^r.
one of the Justices of the Court of Common Pleas for said County
personally appeared the within mentioned William
Porter and acknowledged the within Bill of Sale and
Instrument of Writing as his act and Deed and
desires that the same may be recorded as such according
to Law. Witness my hand & seal the 14th day of August 1785.
